

STROKEWORK DESIGN taught by Pat Landry

This is my rendition of a design by Judy Diephouse. You may put it on any wood piece of your choice. The pattern design is 12 inches tall/or long and 4 inches wide.

PALETTE:

Delta Ceramcoat---

RAW LINEN

MEDIUM FOLIAGE GREEN

DARK FOLIAGE GREEN

LIGHT FOLIAGE GREEN

WHITE

OLD PARCHMENT

GOLDEN BROWN

RED IRON OXIDE

DecoArt Americana---

BLACK GREEN

JADE GREEN

WINTER BLUE

UNIFORM BLUE(I used WEDGEWOOD BLUE)

DEEP MIDNIGHT BLUE

INDIAN TURQUOISE

RAW SIENNA

PREPARATION:

Basecoat the entire surface with RAW LINEN.

I painted the sides and back of my piece with WEDGEWOOD BLUE, you may use a color of your choice from the list above. It will take two or more coats. Dry completely.

Before class: Base coat the stems and the leaves MEDIUM FOLIAGE GREEN.

The tulips blue sections with a mix of WINTER BLUE and UNIFORM BLUE (1:1). Basecoat the yellow areas with OLD PARCHMENT.

In class we will be float shading the leaves and tulips. Then doing the strokes, so practice, practice, practice.
